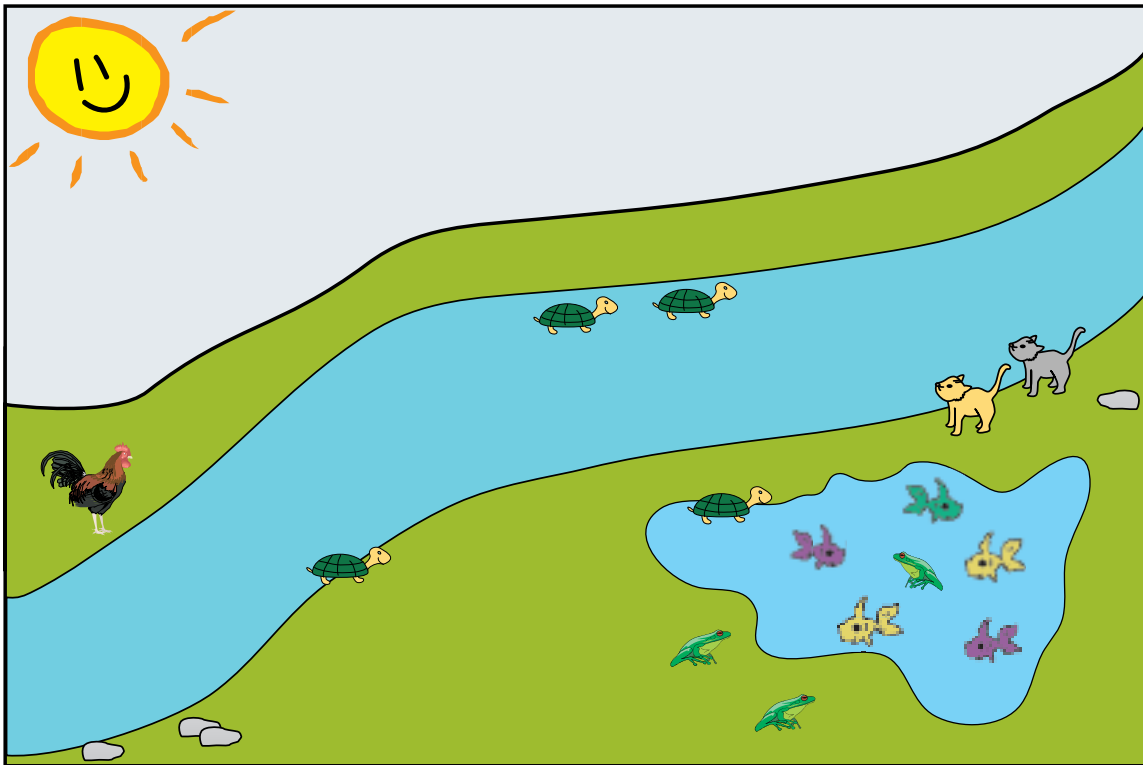
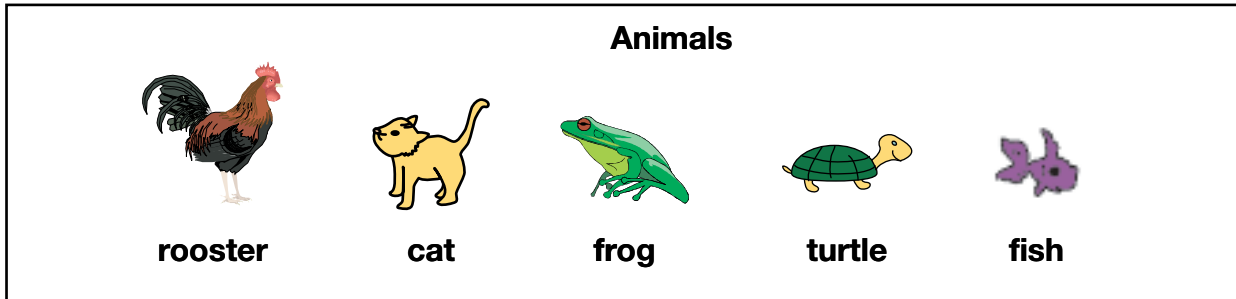


Rooster's Addition Story
