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## Rooster's Addition Story (TG)

Stories and number sentences will vary. Sample story and number sentence: 3 frogs and 4 turtles played together. There were 7 animals playing. 3 frogs +4 turtles $=7$ animals.

## Animal Addition Stories (TG pp. 1-2) Homework

Stories and number sentences will vary. Sample story and number sentence: 1 black fish swam with 3 goldfish in the pond. There were 4 fish altogether. 1 black fish +3 goldfish $=4$ fish.
