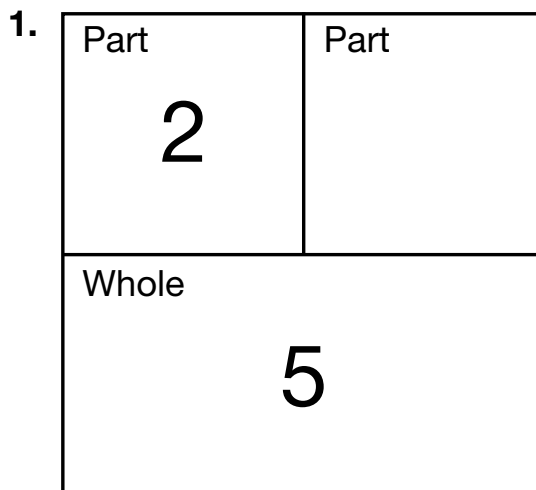


Dear Family Member:

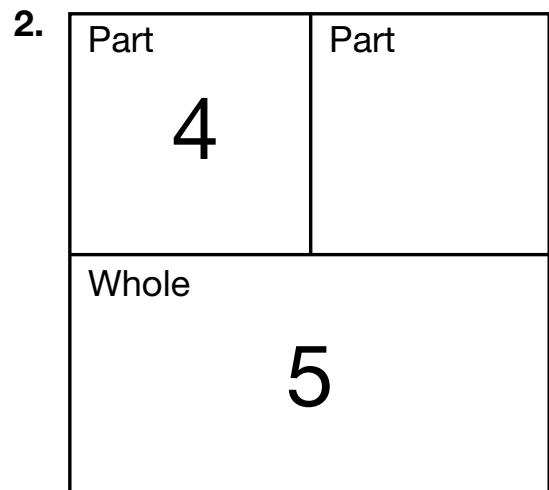

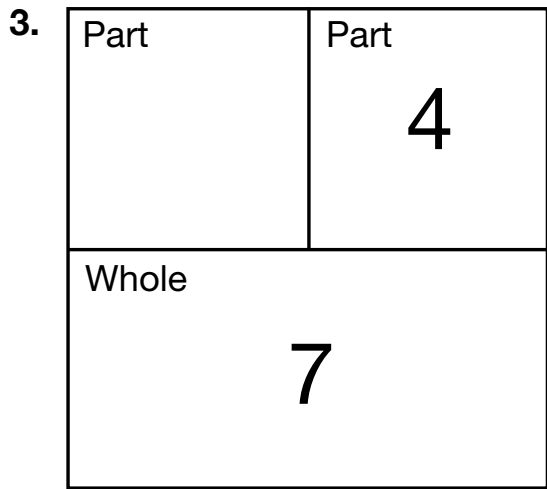
Write the correct number in the empty box. Write a number sentence for each one.



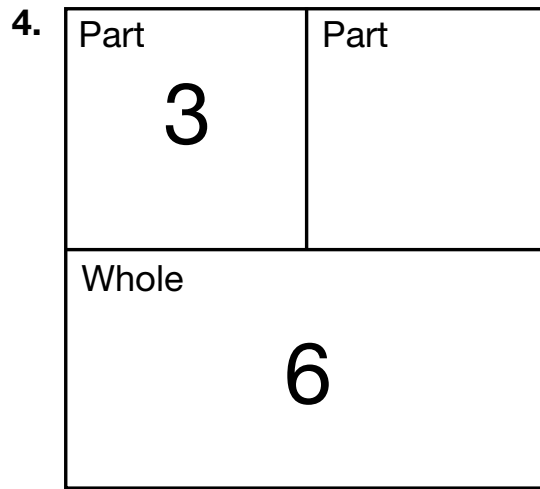
$$2 + \square = 5$$



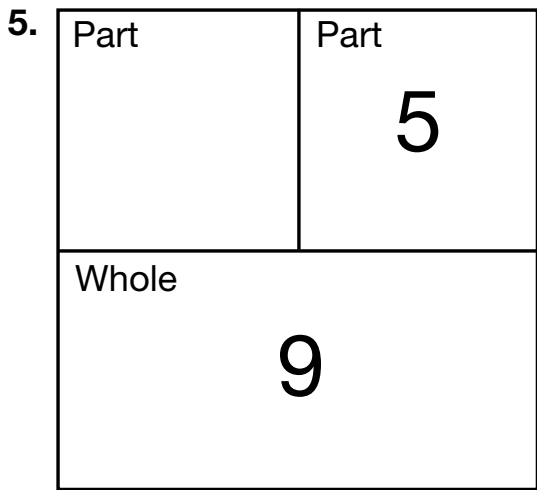
$$4 + \square = 5$$



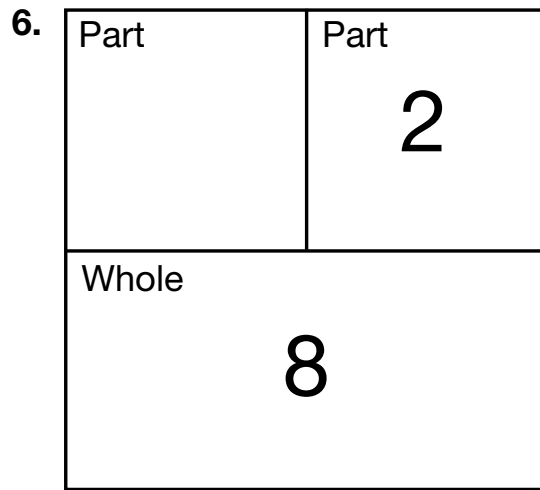
$$\square + 4 = 7$$
