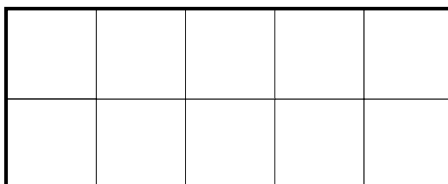
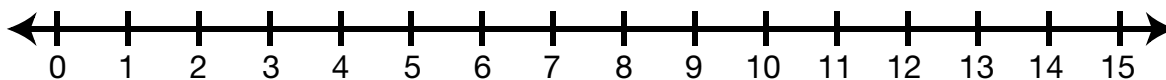


Part 2 Word Problems
