

N Three Trials



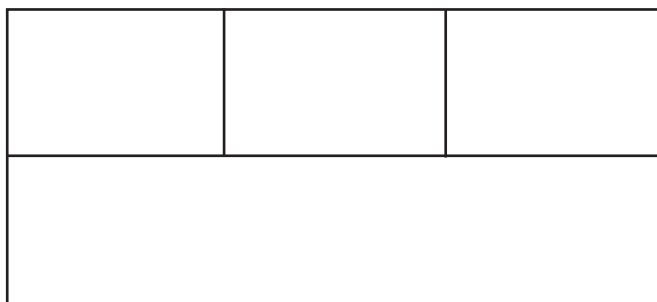
