- $25¢ = 5¢ + 5¢ + 5¢ + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
- $30¢ = 10¢ + 10¢ + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
- $5¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 30¢$
- $10¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
- $5¢ + 10¢ + 5¢ + 10¢ = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
- $25¢ = 20¢ + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
