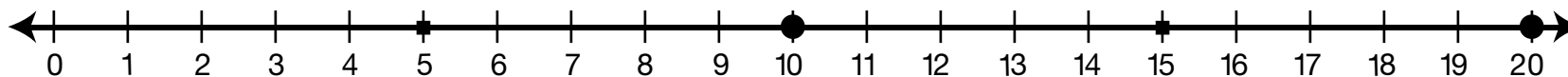
## More Grace and Jerome Problems
