

A Addition Flash Cards: Group C

With a partner, sort the flash cards into three piles: Facts I Know Quickly, Facts I Can Figure Out, and Facts I Need to Learn. Clip cards in the Facts I Know Quickly pile together and place them back into the envelope. Update your *Addition Facts I Know* chart. Practice the facts in the last two piles again.

B Partition Ten

Stand up and find a partner.

1. Face your partner.
2. Player 1 puts his or her arms straight up in the air.
3. Once in the air, Player 1 uses his or her fingers to show a number between 0 and 10.
4. Player 2 puts his or her arms down and displays the number needed to make ten. For example, Player 1 shows 4 fingers and Player 2 shows 6 fingers because $4 + 6 = 10$.
5. On the next turn, Player 2 leads.
