

Fact Families



Dear Family Member:

In school, your child has been learning about fact families. For example, the following number sentences are all part of the same fact family:

$3 + 2 = 5$

$2 + 3 = 5$

$5 - 2 = 3$

$5 - 3 = 2$

As you talk with your child about addition and subtraction sentences, ask him or her to tell you another number sentence in the same fact family.

$7 + 3 = 10$

$3 + 5 = 8$

$7 = 1 + 6$

$6 - 3 = 3$

$2 + 5 = 7$

$5 + 2 = 7$

$5 + 3 = 8$

$7 - 1 = 6$

$4 - 2 = 2$
