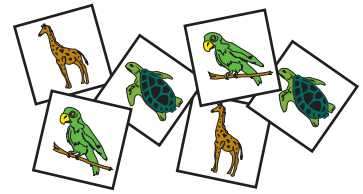


Cost of Zoo Stickers

1. Peter bought 3 rows of stickers. Each row has 3 stickers. Each sticker costs 5 cents. How much does Peter have to pay?

 - A. How many stickers does Peter have?
 - B. What is the total cost of all the stickers?
2. Carla bought 4 rows of stickers. Each row has 4 stickers. Each sticker costs 2¢. How much does Carla have to pay?

 - A. How many stickers does Carla have?
 - B. What is the total cost of all the stickers?

3. Roberto has 60¢. He wants to buy a sheet of stickers with 5 rows. Each row has 2 stickers. Each sticker costs 5¢. Does he have enough money to buy the sheet of stickers?

A. How many stickers are on the sheet?

B. What is the total cost of all the stickers?

C. Does Roberto have enough money?

D. How much does he have left?

4. Fern has a sheet of stickers. The sheet has 2 rows and each row has 5 stickers. If each sticker costs 3¢, what is the total cost of the sheet of stickers?
