Navy	22

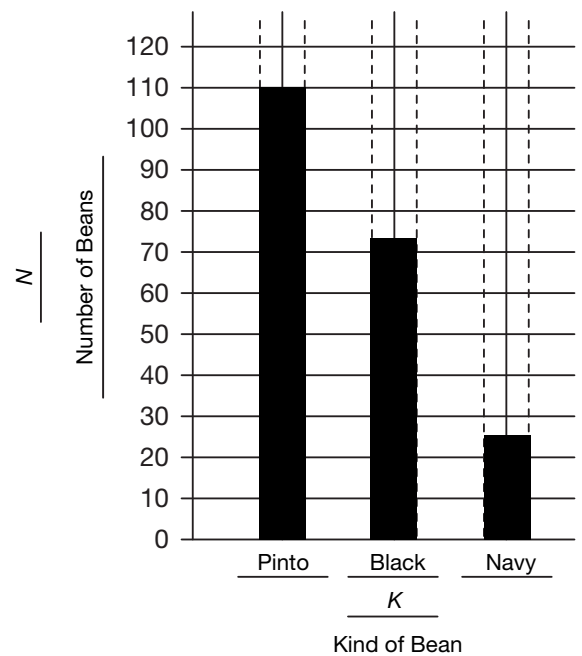
Second Tub

Pinto	115
Black	70
Navy	24
