

**A Triangle Flash Cards: Last Six Facts**

With a partner, use your Triangle Flash Cards to quiz each other on the multiplication facts for the last six facts. One partner covers the corner containing the highest number. This number will be the product. The second person multiplies the two uncovered numbers.

Separate the used cards into three piles: Facts I Know Quickly, Facts I Can Figure Out, and Facts I Need to Learn. Practice the last two piles again and make a list of facts you need to practice at home for homework.

Circle the facts you know quickly on your *Multiplication Facts I Know* chart.

- A. Johnny's house has 7 windows. Each window has 6 panes of glass. How many panes of glass are in Johnny's house?
- B. Johnny's house has 7 shelves. Each shelf has 8 books. How many books are in Johnny's house?
- C. Johnny's house has 7 lamps. Each lamp has 4 light bulbs. How many light bulbs are in Johnny's house?
- D. Explain your strategy for solving Question A.
