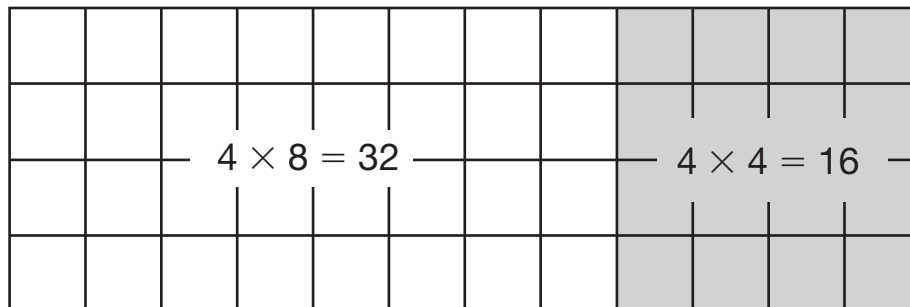


Break Apart



Rosa broke a rectangle apart to find 4×12 . Her solution is shown below.



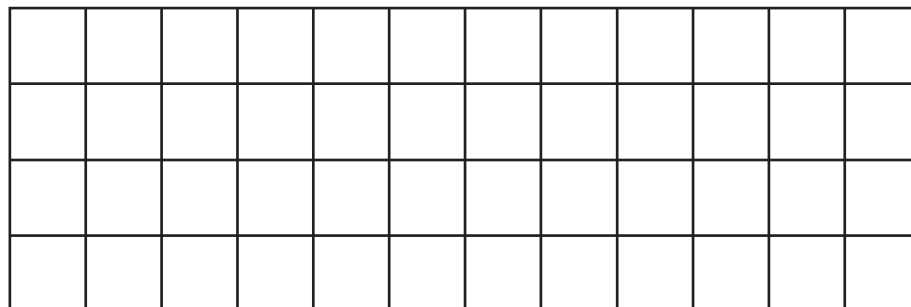
$4 \times 8 = 32$ white squares and $4 \times 4 = 16$ gray squares.

Altogether, there are $4 \times 12 = 4 \times 8 + 4 \times 4$

$$= 32 + 16$$

$$= 48$$
