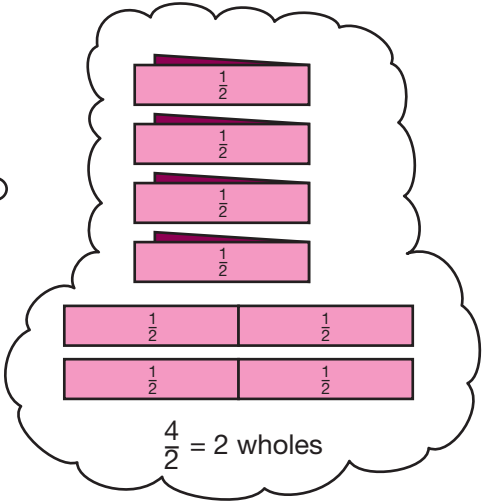
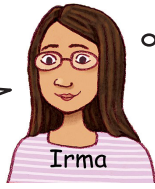


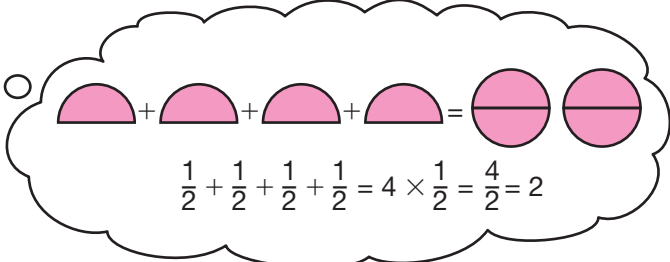
Strategies for $4 \times \frac{1}{2}$

I used fraction strips.

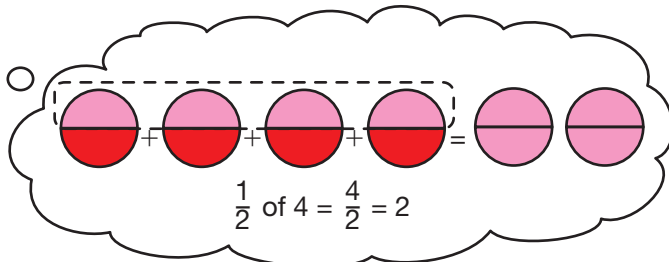
$$4 \times \frac{1}{2} = 2$$

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{4}{2} = 2$$


I used circle pieces. A red circle is one whole.



I thought of this problem as $\frac{1}{2}$ of 4.
