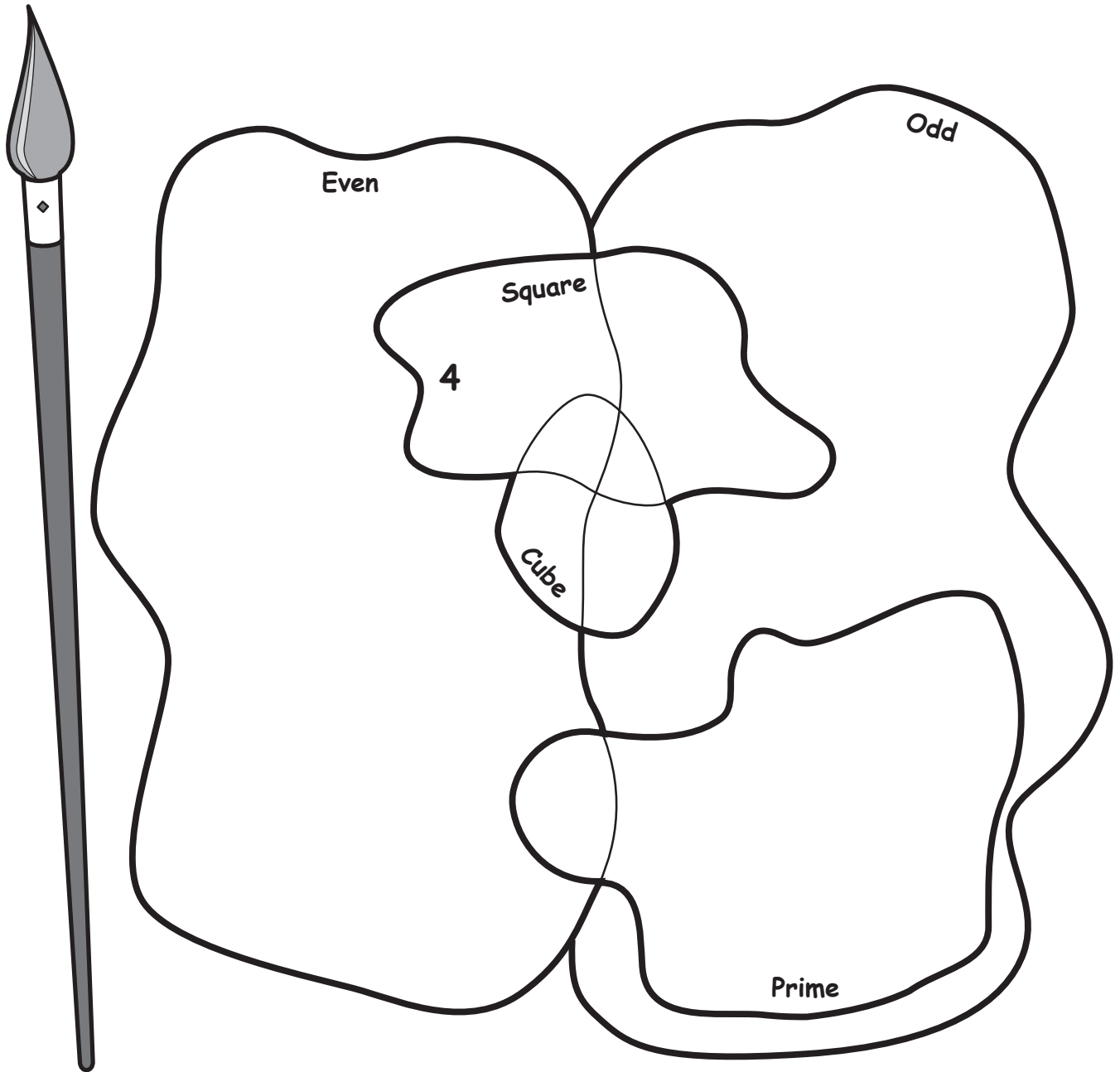


# Number Palette
